Parklands with their greenery, plants, children rides and pavements are quintessential need (write: needs) of residents. Children of a locality come together and play different games in the parks which definitely help (write: helps) them keep a (write: an) active lifestyle.

Remarks

Children of the neighborhood can come together and play different games in the parks and thus lead an active lifestyle.

Similarly, people of elder age group take walks and whole discussion (write: older people / seniors can go for a walk / can enjoy a stroll in the park and interact) with their peers in these open areas.

Remarks

To ask someone to take a walk is to tell them to go away. You go for a walk or enjoy a walk in the park.

Both these things enhance physical and mental health of the old generation.

Nevertheless, housing crisis is too evident (write: severe / serious) to be ignored, and viable solutions should be planned and executed. One possible solution could be demolishing old and dilapidated government buildings in the cities and rebuild (write: rebuilding) them as residential complexes.
